# The Virtue of Humility

In the Gospel and first reading, the focus is on humility. It is really summed up in the parable when Jesus says, "Everyone who exalts himself will be humbled, but the one who humbles himself will be exalted." But what exactly does it mean to be humble? That may sound like a simple question, but I know I often made the mistake of confusing the virtue of humility with a false sense of humility. I once had a teacher explain it this way, and it comes from C.S. Lewis who said, "Humility is not thinking less of yourself, but it's thinking of yourself less." Being humble doesn't mean putting ourselves down, and it doesn't mean thinking we are any less than we are, that is false humility.

The virtue of humility comes from both recognizing our strengths and our weaknesses. We are all created with different gifts and abilities. In our weakness, are we willing to ask for help or do we let our pride get in the way? When we are able to help someone in need, do we do so without expecting anything in return or without feeling superior? St. Augustine used to say, "humility is the foundation of all other virtues" that "no one reaches the kingdom of heaven except by humility." I think it is true if we ever want to live holy lives we have to work on growing in the virtue of humility. The best way to grow in any virtue is by practicing it. A virtue is a habit, it is something that we choose to do over and over until it becomes part of our nature. If you want to grow in virtue of charity, practice being charitable to others. If you want to grow in the virtue of patience, choose a moment to practice being patient.

But virtue is not only a habit that we practice but it is also a gift from God. Another way to grow in virtue is by asking God for it. If you are looking to grow in humility I invite you to pray the Litany of Humility. If you have never heard this prayer before, you can find it online, it is a great prayer that challenges our ego and our pride. The Gospel calls us to grow in humility and to recognize moments in our lives when our pride gets the best of us. Let us all pray to grow in the virtue of humility, remembering humility is not thinking less of yourself, but it is thinking about yourself less often.
