As a boy, my uncle who lived in Safford, my baseball little league coaches, my 4th/5th grade teacher who lived across the street from our house. My 6th grade teacher in Holbrook. Paz de Cristo: Feed, Clothe, and Empower

With social justice and outreach as one of the pillars of this community, St. Patrick has had a long history of going out into the community and partnering with various organizations to help those in need. St. Patrick has been involved with Paz de Cristo for over twenty years and continues to serve every month with a group of dedicated ministers. However, with such a long history there are many who are unaware of the history and the amazing work that Paz de Cristo does everyday.

In 1988, parishioners from St. Timothy's wanted to sponsor a food service and family shelter in the East Valley. With a focus of feeding the hungry, giving drink to the thirsty, clothing the naked, and sheltering the homeless, Paz de Cristo was created. The vision included an interfaith component where multiple faith communities would pool both financial and human resources to serve the needs of our neighbors. In July of 1988, a little yellow house on Country Club Drive served as an emergency food pantry and clothing bank. The first meal was served by Paz de Cristo on September 15, 1988. By January of 1989, dinner was served every night of the year. Paz quickly outgrew the little yellow house and moved to a larger building site in 1993. Paz de Cristo became a separate 501(c)3 nonprofit organization in October of 2008. Since then, the organization has been able to add several additional services to help the community. Paz de Cristo has the mission to empower guests to reach their full potential by removing barriers so they may become more self-sufficient. Paz de Cristo exists to help individuals achieve self-reliance, pride and self-respect. Lives are changed leading to improved economic standing, respect for others and citizenship participation.

Every second Monday of the month, ministers from St. Patrick serve 300-500 meals to those in need. I invite you to prayerfully reflect on the message of Matthew 25:35, "For I was hungry and you gave me something to eat, I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink." 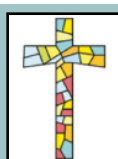



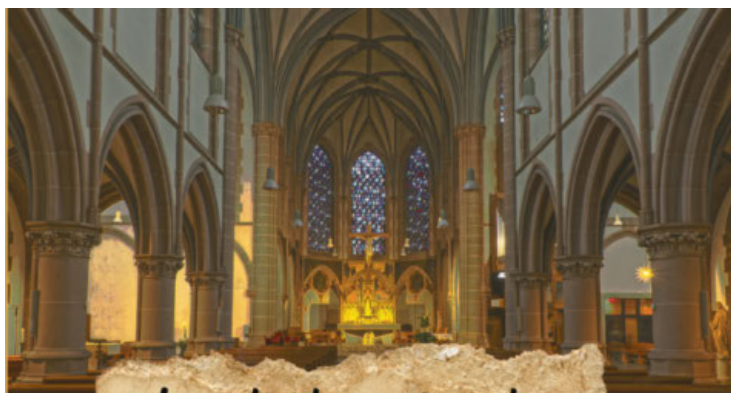
